

Bridal Suite Packing List

- Your outfit; Dress, Shoes, Undergarments
- Jewelry & Accessories
- Perfume – for use and for photos!
- Accessories for photo detail shots ex: ribbon, ring boxes, ring dish etc.
- Cute hanger for your dress in photos!
- Letter to pass to the groom (This is really cute if you have a videographer)
- Phone charger
- Portable speaker (we have wifi)
- Camera, polaroid or selfie stick!
- Hair Accessories and Bobby pins
- Flip flops
- Small emergency kit (Advil, sewing kit, tissues, safety pins)
- Deodorant and other toiletries (Baby powder for your legs under that dress!)
- Mouthwash
- Bring some of your own makeup for 'touch ups' just in case!
- Fabric Steamer and wrinkle releaser
- Gifts for your bridesmaids and mothers
- Thank you notes for vendors/family (if needed)
- Cash for tipping Hair & Makeup vendors and bartenders
- Case of Bottled Water (we have a fridge in the suite)
- Champagne (glasses provided)
- Snacks and paper products
- One large Tote bag to throw everything into at the end of the night!

Wedding Morning Tips:

1. Once all the bridesmaids are done with their hair and makeup have them pack up their personal items into their totes for easy clean up at the end of the night. After a couple of drinks and dancing they won't want to be searching the bridal suite for all their items!
2. If you have a guest book out, ask your bridesmaids to go sign it during the day, often times they do not have time to later in the day!
3. If you LOVE all those flat lay photos on Pinterest bring along your invitation suite, a ring box or cute dish, ribbon, fabric from the bridesmaid dress alteration, or any sentimental items for your photographer to play with!
4. If you are not providing any hangers, ask all your bridesmaids to bring one along for photos! (I purchased a pack of wooden hangers from IKEA and tied a bow on each to match their dress color and it looked adorable in photos)
